ICD files shall be validated against the schema it is claiming conformance to (i.e. indicated in the SCL header of the file).

The LN SCL element requires a InType attribute, and the schema requires an existing LNodeType in the DataTypeTemplate for every declared InType. Therefore there is no other option for a pure client to add an SCL valid LNodeType in the DataTypeTemplate.
